VILLAGE OF WEMBLEY

A BY-LAW REQUIRING THE NUMBERING OF STREETS, AVENUES, AND HOUSES OF THE VILLAGE OF WEMBLEY.

WHEREAS it is expedient for the Village of Wembley to pass a BY-LAW requiring the numbering of Streets, Avenues, and Houses:

THEREFORE be it enacted and it is hereby enacted by the Council of the Village of Wembley

- (1) THAT the Street formerly known as Centre Street, shall hereinafter be known as 100 Street. Streets west of 100 Street shall be numbered up consecutively and Streets east of 100 Street shall be numbered down consecutively according to Map being Schedule "A" of the BY-LAW.
- (2) THAT the Avenue formerly known as Railway Avenue shall hereinafter be known as 100 Avenue. The Avenues North of 100 Avenue shall hereinafter be numbered up consecutively and the Avenues South of 100 Avenue shall be numbered down consecutively according to Map being Schedule "A" of this BY-LAW.
 - (3) THAT House numbering on Avenues shall commence at each street intersection and with even numbers on the North side of each Avenue and odd numbers on the South side of each Avenue, continue numbering upwards in a Westerly direction until the intersection of the next Street. That the first digits in the property number shall indicate the Street from which the numbering commenced, the last two digits of the number being the number of the house as arrived at from this system.
 - (4) THAT house numbering on Streets shall commence at each Avenue intersection, and with even numbers on the West side of each Street and odd numbers on the East side of each Street continue numbering upwards in a Northerly direction until the intersection with the next Avenue. That the first digits in the property number shall indicate the number of the Avenue from which the numbering commenced the last two digits being the number of the house as arrived at from this system.
 - (5) THAT numbers shall be assigned to each building site taking into consideration the size of the lots in that particular residential or business area concerned.
 - at his own expense, to have property numbers shown on or near front entrances, on or before the 1st of September. 1979. Said numbers shall be prominently displayed, shall be at least (3) inches in height and painted in a contrasting colour that can be easily read from the Street or Avenue. It shall be the duty of all property owners to first ascertain the proper number by inquiring at the Town Office.
 - (7) THAT the Town or Village authorities shall as soon as practical erect at each intersection, a post or posts showing Street and Avenue numbers, or where feasible to display such Street or Avenue numbers on corner buildings or telephone or power poles conveniently located. Coats of such street and avenue numbering shall be paid by the Town or Village.

(8) THAT any person or persons violating the provisions of this BY-LAW or not complying with the requirements as set out herein, or any person destroying, tampering with, or changing any number or sign posts placed to comply with this BY-LAW shall on summary conviction before any Justice of the Peace or any Police Magistrate having jurisdiction in the Village of Wembley be liable to the penalty or penalties provided in BY-LAW No. 467 of the Village of Wembley, being a BY-LAW fixing penalties for the infraction of BY-LAWS of the Village of Wembley.

THIS BY-LAW given 1st, 2nd, and by unanimous consent 3rd reading, and finally passed this 14th day of May, A.D. 1979.
