A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF WEMBLEY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA BEING BY-LAW No. 539, PROHIBITING THE USE OF FLASHING WARNING LAMPS ON SCHOOL BUSES ON ROADS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF WEMBLEY.

WHEREAS, Section 105(8), of the Highway Traffic Amendment Act, 1986, allows a municipality to pass a by-law covering roads under its jurisdiction, prohibiting the use of flashing warning lamps on school buses,

WHEREAS, the school authority, the County of Grande Prairie No. 1, has indicated that they would like such a by-law passed,

THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Wembley hereby prohibits the use of flashing warning lamps on school buses within the boundaries of the Town of Wembley, in the Province of Alberta.

This by-law comes into effect upon the 1st day of December, 1986.
